## U.S.G.A. RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

 Except As Modified by Local Rules- Out of Bounds: Identified by white lines, white stakes and boundary fences on every hole. In the absence of white stakes, there are lamp posts which designate out of bounds on the left (condo) side of most holes (tee to green). The lamp post is out of bounds. All paved roads and parking lots are also out of bounds. Any ball that crosses the road and comes back in play on another hole is out of bounds
- Hole \#9: The entire wooded area on the right side of the 9th hole is an environmental area played as a red penalty area, however you are not permitted to play your shot from the area. Beyond the wooded area is a parking lot which is out of bounds. If it is not known or virtually certain that the ball is in the penalty area it must be treated as lost or out of bounds.
- Flower Beds: Decorative flower beds and cultivated areas are "no play zones" from which free relief is mandatory.
